



2025 OBSIDIAN **triple junction** VOLCANIC WHITE WINE

UNITING WEST COAST VOLCANICS Over twenty years ago, we planted a vineyard in one of the top 100 most active volcanic regions in the United States, beginning our fascination with geology, plate tectonics, and volcanic influences on wine. Our curiosity inspired us to look north where a string of subduction volcanoes stretch from our vineyard in the Mayacamas Range of California through Oregon and Washington, all the way to the Canadian border. As we traveled there to learn more, we found a community of wine grape growers that – like us – farm remote and elevated sites in volcanic soils and facings. We found that we have more in common with these distant sites (and partners) than with our own neighboring valley vineyards.

Inspired by these regions and the work that they are doing, we hatched an idea to bring together these sites in a volcanic wine that we call Triple Junction. The Triple Junction is rare convergence of three tectonic plates that form the subduction volcanoes of California and the Pacific Northwest, as the Pacific Plate causes the Juan de Fuca Plate to slip under the North American Plate. We launched our first Volcanic Red from the 2021 vintage.

In 2025, inspired by the great Volcanic White wines of the world, we created our first Triple Junction Volcanic White. The core of the wine is a blend from basaltic flows on multiple sites in the Columbia Valley, notably the Columbia Gorge and Yakima Valley.

TASTING NOTES Triple Junction Volcanic White has the signature tension and minerality of white wines grown in cold, unforgiving volcanic sites wrapped in the intense aromatics and flavors born of elevation and solar exposure. Aromas of citrus zest and blossoms, lemongrass, and honeysuckle lead to mouth-watering flavors of green pear and lime and a surprisingly generous texture. A bright, crisp, quenching wine with plenty of intrigue yet oh so deliciously easy to drink. Goes down so easily we had to put it in a one liter bottle.
