WHAT A blend of 9 white grapes from 14 volcanic vineyard sites showcases West Coast Volcanic character: intensity, tension, minerality.

SIZE One liter bottle (30% more than standard)

NOTES Intense aromas and flavors of orange blossom, lime, lemongrass, honeysuckle, and green pear. Crisp, fresh, clean, stony, juicy.

DIGITS Four main grapes: Viognier, Albariño, Sauvignon Blanc, & Pinot Gris (aka Pinot Grigio) 13.7% abv, 784 cases produced.

WHY Inspired by volcanic white wines of Italy, Greece, Portugal, and Hungary, sourced from volcanic sites of the West Coast of America.

WHERE Grown primarily on basaltic rock sites across Washington's Colombia Valley, notably Yakima Valley & Colombia Gorge.

NAME West Coast volcanoes are formed by the collision of 3 tectonic plates, aka the Triple Junction.



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
